<u>FEE</u>: \$15 for neutered/spayed dogs and \$20 for intact dogs. Make checks payable to "Town of Sudbury." Dogs six months of age or older must be licensed. Any past due fees must be paid at time of renewal.

MAIL: If licensing by mail, include a postage paid, self-addressed envelope. Two stamps are required. Additional forms are available on the Town website at www.sudbury.ma.us/clerk.

<u>ONLINE</u>: Online licensing is for renewals and not for dogs new to Sudbury. You may renew your dog's Sudbury license by scanning the QR code or visiting <u>www.sudbury.ma.us/dog</u>. Please note that there will be a convenience fee charged for credit card transactions. First time licensing must be done by mail or in-person at Town Clerk's office. Rabies and spay/neuter (if applicable) info is needed.

*License(s) will not be issued unless fees and all required documentation have been received.

*In compliance with Town Bylaw V, Section 3A, a late fee of \$25.00 per dog, in addition to the license fee, a late charge will be imposed if payment and required paperwork are not received in the Town Clerk's Office or paid online by the end of business on April 2, 2025. Additional fines may be assessed if payment is not received by June 2, 2025.
