



Sherman's Bridge Rehabilitation

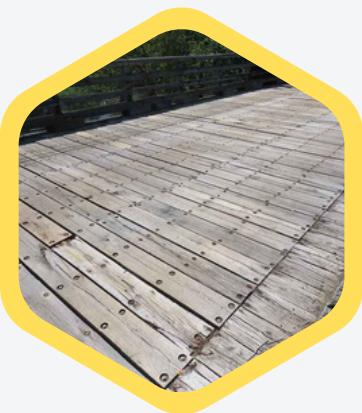
Sudbury and Wayland are proposing a rehabilitation project to strengthen Sherman's Bridge. This work will replace the wooden deck with a laminated timber surface and asphalt layer, add modern crash-tested railings, and complete targeted structural repairs. These upgrades will meet MassDOT repair requirements, reduce maintenance, improve water quality in the Sudbury River, and provide a safer, smoother crossing for all travelers.

- ✓ Work will last about **3–6 months** once construction begins (targeted for summer/fall 2026).
