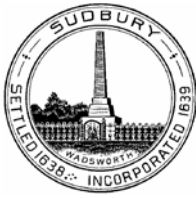

**DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING TRANSFER TANK FUEL STORAGE AND
TANK TRUCK PERMIT OF APPLICATION**

1. Leave permit number blank. Sudbury Fire will assign the number.
2. Enter date of application.
3. Fully complete company information and contact information.
4. Enter the number to the capacity of the storage tank.
5. Complete vehicle information.
6. Sign signature of application.
7. Upon completion of the form, schedule an inspection by calling the Office Manager at 978-440-5314.
8. A check for \$50 payable to the Town of Sudbury will be required at time of inspection.

Notes:

1. Inspection will confirm the MA DFS requirements of Transfer Tank Inspection or Tank Vehicle Inspection, whichever is applicable.
2. Permit will be issued for one vehicle. If multiple vehicles in fleet, each vehicle will require its own permit of application, \$50 fee and inspection. Include a copy of the registration with the application of permit.
3. Permit of Storage is valid for maximum of 2 years.
4. If vehicle is replaced, the permit is voided and a new permit of application will need to be submitted.
5. **MA DFS is no longer providing stickers. A copy of the approved permit to be stored in vehicle is proof of compliance.**
