## **Who Should Get a Booster Dose?**

Everyone ages 5 years and older should receive a primary series of vaccine and 1 booster dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.

**1st Booster:** CDC recommends a booster of Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for:

- Most children and teens, at least 5 months after the final dose in the primary series
- Children who are moderately or severely immunocompromised, at least 3 months after the final dose in the primary series

**You are Considered Up to Date:** Immediately after getting 1st booster – this is important for some schools, camps, and summer programs.

**2nd Booster:**

- CDC recommends a 2nd booster of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine at least 4 months after the 1st booster for children and teens who are moderately or severely immunocompromised. Call your pediatrician to discuss this.

Experts continue to recommend that [everyone get vaccinated](#) and boosted, regardless of whether they've had COVID-19 in the past. As cases increase across the country and we proceed with summer travel and camps, a booster dose will safely help restore and enhance protection against a severe COVID-19 infection. -[American Academy of Pediatrics](#)
