A **Spring Health Fair** will be held in conjunction with the Mammography Van at Haskell Field from 10am-12noon featuring many community and town partners promoting wellness in Sudbury. Stop by to learn about the great health-related resources we have in town and pick up some tips on staying well through spring and summer.

The Mammography Van is the only mobile mammography program in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. It provides digital screening mammograms and (depending upon availability) breast health education to women 40 years of age and older. Skilled mammography technologists from Dana-Farber perform the exams, and images are interpreted by board-certified radiologists with extensive experience dedicated to mammography.

Dana-Farber's Mammography Van possesses a valid license and certificate of inspection issued by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health.
