WHAT IS THE FLU?

Influenza ("flu") is a contagious disease that spreads around the United States every year, usually between October and May.

Flu is caused by influenza viruses, and is *spread mainly by coughing*, *sneezing*, *and close contact*.

Anyone can get flu. Flu strikes suddenly and can last several days. Symptoms vary by age, but can include:

fever/chills, sore throat, muscle aches, fatigue, cough, headache, runny or stuffy nose

HOW CAN FLU VACCINE HELP?

Flu vaccine can:

- 1. Prevent you from getting flu.
- 2. Make flu *less severe* if you do get it.
- 3. *Keep you from spreading* flu to your family and friends.
