» » OUR HISTORY

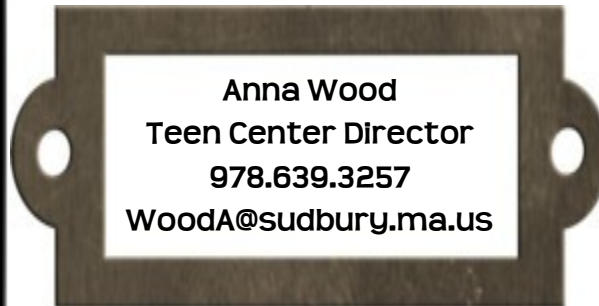

FRIENDS OF TEEN CENTER

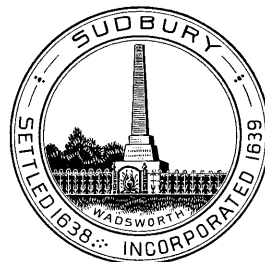

How Does it Work?

- ❦ Teen Center events are open for Sudbury students in 7th and 8th grade. Guests and out of town residents are not allowed.
- ❦ Parents must register their child to be part of Teen Center events. This can be done by filling out a one time only registration form that can be found on the Teen Center website. Students are then given a photo ID that they will need to have with them to get into events.
- ❦ Admission is charged at the door. Snacks and beverages can be purchased at the event.
- ❦ Doors open at 7:30pm. Events end at 10:00pm
- ❦ All Teen Center events are supervised by the Teen Center Director and staff, a uniformed police officer, and parent volunteers.

Programs & Events

The Jean Lind Teen Center offers Sudbury teens with a variety of events and programs:

Friday Night Social



During the school year, the Teen Center hosts monthly Friday night events for 7th and 8th grade students. Some events are for 7th graders only, and other events are for 8th graders only. Activities typically include:

- ❦ Dancing to the music of a live DJ
- ❦ Game room featuring Wii, Xbox 360, Dance Dance Revolution, Rock Band, Arcade games, and more
- ❦ Snack bar with sodas, candy, and snacks
- ❦ Pool tables, ping pong, foos ball, and air hockey

Teen Center RULES!

These rules have been established to ensure the safety and well being of all participants. Parental cooperation is essential to the program's continued success.

- Out of town guests are not permitted to attend Teen Center events. These events are restricted to 7th & 8th graders who live in Sudbury and/or attend Sudbury schools or are home schooled.
- The possession or use of weapons, alcohol, illegal drugs or tobacco products will not be tolerated. Appropriate action, including police involvement, will be taken.
- During Teen Center events, no student is allowed to leave the Teen Center before closing unless a parent or parent-authorized individual comes inside to pick them up. Anyone disobeying this rule will not be allowed to attend the next event and his/her parent(s) will be notified.
- If a student is disrespectful of staff, volunteers, peers, or equipment, their parent(s) will be called and the student may be removed from the facility.
- Dress code is the same as that of The Curtis Middle School.
