We are thrilled to report that we had another wonderful summer of Camp. The summer of 2022 brought 1,221 campers onto our property, including 450 Sudbury residents and 43 scholarship recipients. We also had 69 Sudbury residents on staff this year, helping bring “summer as it should be” to our campers. It was great to be back to normal, with a return to pre-Covid programming, including our Special Events and Overdays.



HOPESudbury hosted its Third Annual Fishing Derby on property the last weekend in August. This year’s event included some exciting additions, such as ice cream from The Chill Wagon, a Remote Control Car racetrack, entertainment from Noteworthy Experiences music students, and face painting. Over 70 families participated in the event, and HOPESudbury raised over \$1300 for local families in need.

Camp Sewataro families contributed to a food drive for the Sudbury Community Food Pantry in August, collecting a total of 35 boxes of nonperishable donations. We are very excited to continue our partnership with the Sudbury Community Food Pantry this year, and look forward to welcoming the wonderful group of volunteers (and their banana boxes!) back on property next week, as they gear up for the 2022-23 school drives.





The Fall event calendar is busy, with local Scouting Groups, family gatherings, and some exciting kick off events hosted by Sudbury Family Network, Trinity Church, and The Sudbury Bakers. We are busy planning our Third Annual Halloween event, and looking forward to welcoming residents back for this fun holiday celebration.

We are also excited to get to work on a number of property updates as we work on improving accessibility and opening up a resident swim program in the summer of 2023.
