We are incredibly proud to share that Scott Brody, Manager at Sewataro and at Everwood Day Camp and Director Emeritus at Camps Kenwood and Evergreen, has been named this year's recipient of the American Camp Association's Distinguished Service Award. Scott has been an invaluable asset to Camp Sewataro over the past 6 years, and his contributions to the Camp Community over the past 40 are too many to list. Meanwhile, our year round team continues preparations for the Summer of 2026. At this point, we are 2% ahead of enrollment totals from last season, with applications still rolling in every week. We continue to work closely with the Town Social Worker's office, who continue to receive inquiries from Sudbury residents about options for summer childcare. We communicate with their office weekly as they identify eligible families and assist with the application process.

We have hired 148 staff thus far, including 53 Sudbury residents. That is on pace with previous years, and we anticipate being fully staffed in the next few months. We are making some minor adjustments to swim instruction, and are working hard to add some exciting new elements to our Extended Day program and to the last day of camp.

Although there is still much melting to be done, the longer days have us very excited about the summer ahead.
