

Home Delivery Policy

The Goodnow Library, in collaboration with the Sudbury Senior Center, offers “Goodnow to Go,” a materials delivery service, to Sudbury residents who are valid Minuteman cardholders and are unable to come to the library due to a temporary or permanent disabling condition. If an eligible resident of Sudbury does not have a valid library card, the circulation department will help them to obtain a card.

This service will be provided free of charge to Sudbury residents in private homes or apartment buildings. Residents of nursing homes, rehabs or other institutions are not eligible for this service.

Patrons wishing to use this service will fill out this form [\[link to form\]](#), indicating their relevant information and material preferences. Materials will be selected by patron or by patron in discussion with Goodnow Library staff or Senior Center volunteer.

A Senior Center volunteer will deliver materials to locations and return them to the library when the circulation period expires.

Deliveries and pick-ups will occur approximately every two weeks. Reminder notices will be provided if desired. No late fines will be assessed, and some leniency may be allowed for lost and damaged items, which will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

The following limitations apply:

- Goodnow materials only will be loaned
- 8-10 items may be borrowed at one time
- Equipment (Playviews, etc. will not be loaned)
- High demand, new items on the waitlist will not generally be loaned, but exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis
- Delivery will be made only within Sudbury
